







CUSTOMER CHECK LIST FOR GAS LOGS/GAS INSERTS

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Appliance	Description	Picture
Heatilator/Heat-n-Glo Gas Inserts, and Fireplaces	12" flex line, with shutoff. Terminates in 1/2" MIP female fitting on shutoff. Terminates on LEFT for gas inserts or fireplaces.	
Kozy Heat Gas Inserts	3/8" female flare fitting on 18" aluminum flex line. Terminates on LEFT for gas inserts.	
Regency Gas Inserts	3/8" MIP threaded fitting on side of gas valve. Terminated in CENTER BOTTOM for gas inserts.	
Heatilator/Heat-n-Glo Gas Logs	3/8" female FIP flare fitting on 18" aluminum flex line. Terminates on RIGHT for gas logs.	
Empire Gas Logs	3/8" MIP threaded fitting on side of gas valve. Terminates on RIGHT for gas logs.

Installation Planning for Gas Inserts: It is usually best for Hearthside to install the insert and the liner prior to the plumber coming. Hearthside will leave the insert partially installed, allowing the plumber to make the gas connection and pressure test the unit. Hearthside will then return, and finish the installation after the gas line has been connected.
